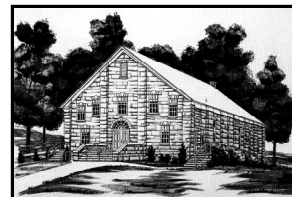

It's full of Bible stories, a daily memory verse, games, crafts, songs and snacks. The participants are aged 9 and under while the deaf teens and the mothers of the children assist.
