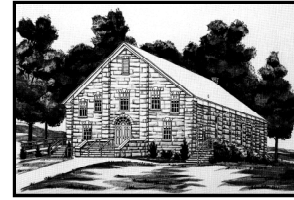


Missionaries of the Month: Nancy Marshall has been serving the deaf community in Orange Walk Town, Belize with VMM and EMM since 2005. She says, "Please pray for the five deaf teens who have a summer school program for three weeks July 4-22. They will be freshman in high school this fall and need to take the three weeks of orientation classes. The biggest difficulty is that they are going to two separate high schools (their choice), but we do not have qualified sign language interpreters for them. Belize simply does not yet have an interpreter training program or a system to test who is qualified. The woman interpreting at one of the high schools just started signing in January and has a lot yet to learn. Pray that the students are patient and can pick up the information."
