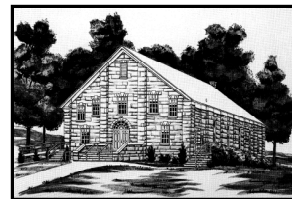

She organizes a Friday night Bible study split into separate groups of adults and children. The teens take turns taking care of the children. They identify one Bible verse each week to study. Nancy gives an object lesson if possible and teaches the verse. Everyone writes the verse in their booklet and practices it all week. Those who have it memorized the next week get a prize. The Deaf adults love this and some meet mid-week to help each other practice.
